NOTICE TO ATTEND A-OK PARENTING PROGRAM

You are a party to a family law action in which issues of parental rights and responsibilities are to be determined. In order to assist the Court in making the best decisions for the children and to attempt to minimize the negative impact this matter may have on the children, the Court, in the exercise of its authority to order family counseling, has developed a program intended to provide parents with information on how parents' separation affects the children.

Your attendance is required by local court rule as authorized by state statutes and Supreme Court Rules, and must be completed. The program is intended to benefit all parties equally, but it is your children who will gain the most from your participation.

There is a one-time attendance fee of \$30.00 per person which is payable at the start of the class. Registration is made upon the filing of your divorce/dissolution. After the filing of your action, the Court will send a letter advising each party of the assigned date and time of the class he/she is required to attend.

The program is every other month in the Courtroom of the Mercer County Court of Common Pleas, 3rd Floor - Room 303, Mercer County Courthouse, Celina, Ohio, on the following days and times:

4th Tuesday of the listed months: January, March, May, July, September & November - 6:00 p.m. - 9:00 p.m.

- March 28, 2017
- May 23, 2017
- July 25, 2017
- September 26, 2017
- November 28, 2017

Please enter the courthouse by the north door (Livingston Street), the only entrance open for this program. **Registration will begin at 5:30 p.m. LATE ARRIVALS WILL NOT BE ADMITTED.** You are required to sign in to receive credit and you must be present during the entire program to receive a certificate. If you are late, you will not be admitted for that session. If you leave prior to the conclusion of the program, you will not receive a certificate.

Payment of \$30 must be made the evening of the class. **(NOTE: Payments must be made in cash)** A partial or full fee waiver may be granted provided that proof of income is provided along with the proper affidavit prepared by your attorney and submitted in writing at least two weeks prior to the class.

Attendance is mandatory. If you fail to attend on your assigned date, a court order may issue for your attendance.
