Sealed bids will be received by the Board of County Commissioners of Mercer County, Ohio until 10:00 a.m. on August 21, 2008 at the, Central Service Building, 220 West Livingston Street, Room A 201, Celina, Ohio for the furnishing of all labor and materials and all work incident there to in accordance with the drawings and/or specifications for the Amstutz - Downey - Evers Ditch No. SWCD 08-115 located in Sections 7 & 8, Jefferson Township and Sections 17, 18, & 20, Butler Township, Mercer County, Ohio.

Bids will be opened and read aloud at 10:00 a.m. in the office of the Board of County Commissioners.

Bids must be accompanied by a bid guarantee in accordance with Section 153.54 of the Ohio Revised Code. The bid guarantee shall be in the form of either:

1. A bond for the full amount of the bid, or
2. A certified check, cashier's check, or letter of credit pursuant to Chapter 1305 of the Ohio Revised Code equal to ten percent (10%) of the bid. Upon entering a contract, a performance bond in the amount of one hundred percent (100%) of the project will be required.

Proposal blanks, plans, and specifications are on file and may be secured from the office of the Mercer County Engineer, 321 Riley Street, Celina, Ohio 45822.

Award of the contract will be made on the basis of the lowest and best bid submitted.
