

LEGAL NOTICE

Mercer County presently participates in the National Flood Insurance Program (NFIP) administered by the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA). FEMA has updated the flood hazard data for our community and issued a Flood Insurance Rate Map (FIRM) that will become effective on May 16, 2012.

Mercer County has prepared new regulations on Flood Damage Reduction to reference the new flood map and flood study by FEMA. The adoption of the new Flood Damage Reduction Regulations is necessary for Mercer County to remain in the National Flood Insurance Program and for property owners to be eligible to purchase NFIP flood insurance policies.

A copy of the proposed Flood Damage Reduction Regulations is available for public review during regular business hours at the office of the Board of County Commissioners, 220 West Livingston Street, Rm. A201, Celina, Ohio.

The Board of County Commissioners of Mercer County, Ohio has set the date and time of March 13, 2012 at 3:15 p.m. for the first public hearing. The second public hearing has been set for March 20, 2012 at 3:15 p.m. Both hearings will be held at the office of the Board of County Commissioners at 220 West Livingston Street, Rm. A201, Celina, Ohio.
