Instructions to Voter

1. **To vote**, you must completely darken the oval (●) at the left of the candidate or answer of your choice.
2. **Do not mark the ballot** for more choices than allowed. Please see permitted number of choices directly below title of office.
3. If you mark the ballot for more choices than permitted, that contest or question will not be counted.
4. If you cast a vote for a candidate whose name is printed on the ballot, do not write that candidate's name on the write-in candidate line.
5. **To cast a write-in vote**, darken the oval (●) to the left of the line provided and write in the candidate's name.
6. **If you make a mistake or want to change your vote**, please return your ballot to a precinct election official and obtain a new one. You may ask for a new ballot up to two times.

Shall a levy be imposed by the Coldwater Exempted Village School District for the purpose of

**AVOIDING AN OPERATING DEFICIT**

in the sum of \$550,000 per year, and a levy of taxes to be made outside of the ten-mill limitation estimated by the county auditor to average four and ten-hundredths mills (4.1) for each dollar of valuation, which amounts to forty-one cents (\$0.41) for each one hundred dollars of valuation, for a period of five (5) years, commencing in 2012, first due in calendar year 2013?

An additional tax for the benefit of the Mercer County - Celina City Health Department for the purpose of current expenses at a rate not exceeding six tenths of a mill (0.6) for each one dollar of valuation, which amounts to six cents (\$0.06) for each one hundred dollars of valuation, for a period of five (5) years, commencing in 2012, first due in calendar year 2013.
