Instructions to Voter

1. **To vote**, you must completely darken the oval (●) at the left of the candidate or answer of your choice.
2. **Do not mark the ballot** for more choices than allowed. Please see permitted number of choices directly below title of office.
3. If you mark the ballot for more choices than permitted, that contest or question will not be counted.
4. If you cast a vote for a candidate whose name is printed on the ballot, do not write that candidate's name on the write-in candidate line.
5. **To cast a write-in vote**, darken the oval (●) to the left of the line provided and write in the candidate's name.
6. **If you make a mistake or want to change your vote**, please return your ballot to a precinct election official and obtain a new one. You may ask for a new ballot up to two times.

**PROPOSED BOND ISSUE AND
TAX LEVY**

**New Bremen Local School
District**

**A majority affirmative vote is necessary
for passage**

Shall bonds be issued by the New Bremen Local School District for the purpose of constructing school facilities under the Classroom Facilities Assistance Program of the Ohio School Facilities Commission and locally funded initiatives related thereto: furnishing and equipping the same; and improving the sites thereof, in the principal amount of \$13,000,000, to be repaid annually over a maximum period of 33 years, and levy a property tax outside the ten-mill limitation, estimated by the county auditor to average over the bond repayment period 7.3 mills for each one dollar of tax valuation, which amounts to \$0.73 for every \$100 of tax valuation to pay the annual debt charges on the bonds, and to pay debt charges on any notes issued in anticipation of those bonds?

Shall an additional levy of taxes be made for a continuing period of time to benefit the New Bremen Local School District, the proceeds of which shall be used to provide funds for the acquisition, construction, enlargement, renovation, and financing of permanent improvements at a rate not exceeding 1 mill for each one dollar of tax valuation, which amounts to \$0.10 for each \$100 of tax valuation?
