BIRTH CERTIFICATES (Updated)

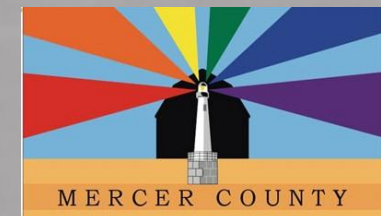
