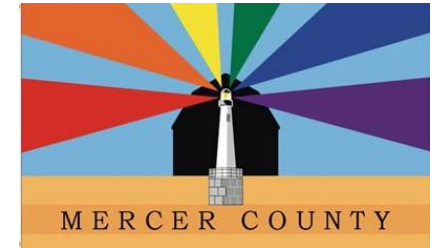
CAR SEATS & BOOSTERS
