## Only AUTHORIZED individuals will be able to obtain un-redacted certified copies. An <u>AUTHORIZED</u> person is as follows:

The person who is the subject of the Discharge	Photo ID required
A County Veterans Service Officer	Confirm authorization in Recorder's DD214 file
An Attorney in Fact	Notarized letter by subject giving authorization
An Executor or Administrator of an Estate	Court papers
A funeral home director	Business card & ID
